1. Are there outline exhibit briefs for the Nature and Culture, and Innovation galleries?

There is nothing formal that MOSH can present at this time. We anticipate extensive collaboration with the selected exhibit designer to formulate a strategy for each exhibit.

2. Is there an anticipated budget scale for the delivery of both galleries?

Not at this time. MOSH has earmarked approximately \$20mm currently for all exhibits but this is subject to change once exhibit design has started.

3. What is the anticipated timeframe for the development and delivery of the galleries?

MOSH currently anticipates project opening by July 31, 2028, which is subject to change.

4. Can you confirm that MOSH requires hard copies + flash drives by the 5/16 deadline?

Yes, the deadline is 5/16/24.

5. Can you provide an update on MOSH's current stage in the design process? How much progress has been made in designing both scopes of work?

The Exhibit Design process is still in a conceptual phase. The architecture of the building is also at the conceptual level.

6. Is Local Projects, the original exhibit designer, still involved in the project? If yes, in what capacity?

Local Projects worked on a conceptual design. With the city of Jacksonville's recent involvement of the project, along with a new CEO of MOSH, the Exhibit Design RFQ has been reissued.

7. Are there any plans to release additional exhibit RFQs in the near future?

No

8. Are all the experiences outlined in this scope intended for the same gallery?

The scope would encompass a variety of different exhibits and themes.

9. Could you provide details on the square footage and ceiling height of this space?

There is approximately 25,000 sq ft total allocated to Innovation, Nature, and culture permanent exhibits (7,500-8,500 for each). Ceiling heights will be different for the 2 floors. As of now, one floor is 14' and the other is 25'. The sq ft and ceiling heights could change as the design is still being developed.

10. Are there any budget constraints or an estimated cost per square foot for this portion of the project?

With this solicitation being qualifications based only, we haven't nailed down an exact budget number for Exhibit Design yet.

11. What is the proposed project schedule for this scope of work?

Specifically for the Exhibit Design process, Conceptual Design through Design Development is expected to be from June 2024 through October 2025.
